Follows protocol in detail for opening and closing of all point of sale registers in the Theater. Prepares and completes all paperwork timely and accurately to include closing reconciliations reports, accounts receivables, ordering supplies, stocking and inventory. Required to operate theater equipment; digital sound system, digital video projector, popcorn machine, state lighting, carpet extractor and pop dispenser machines. Perform theater maintenance and janitorial duties. Maintain cleanliness of entire concessions area including cooking equipment, counters, glass display cases, condiment areas, preparation areas and stock room shelves. Ensure security of all point of sale registers including box office tickets sales. Capability to communicate and work effectively with guests in a fast paced high-volume setting. Proficient communication skills with customers, supervisors, coworkers and vendors.

- Knowledge of point of sale software, digital and concession equipment and telephone movie hotline.

- Skill in operation of theater equipment and ability to handle technical issues.
